QUARTER-FINAL ROUNDS

On the Harrison & Harrison organ at St Albans Cathedral

Variations & Fugue on a Gregorian Theme (free-style) max. timing 12'

Charles TOURNEMIRE Free-choice of contrasting movements from L'Orgue Mystique max.12'

SEMI-FINAL ROUNDS

Total timing of round 22'

On the Peter Collins organ at St Saviour's Church, St Albans

A Toccata in the 'Italian' style of the 17c or 18c An improvised Kyrie with sung alternatim chant by Henri du Mont (5 organ verses). Free-choice style

On the Mander organ in St Peter's Church, St Albans

PAUL PATTERSON 4 contrasting movements from *Games* (commissioned by IOFS 1977)
THREE CONTRASTING MOVEMENTS BASED ON LITERARY TEXTS with improvised percussion using the same instrumentation as Rogg's *Incantations*

The movements of *Games* will be given to competitors during Registration in St Albans. Competitors will also have rehearsal time with the percussionist.

FINAL ROUND

On the Harrison & Harrison organ at St Albans Cathedral

Charles TOURNEMIRE Te Deum

Improvisation on THREE movements in symphonic style (1st mvt. Sonata form) max.20'

The themes will be handed to each competitor 40 minutes before their allocated performance time, who will have use of a piano or keyboard during this period
